Be a New Mexico resident and have 2.5 cumulative high school GPA or 20 ACT or 1030 score (national test), and be a New Mexico high school graduate, New Mexico General Educational Development (GED) recipient, or New Mexico High School Equivalency Test (HiSET) recipient in the semester preceding the first semester of attendance.	Tuition	First semester

Note: If you did not graduate from an accredited New Mexico high school, or complete the New Mexico GED or New Mexico HiSET, your award will be based on national ACT/SAT scores.



## How do my scores add up?

Your SAT total comes from the following sections: **Evidence-Based Reading/Writing | Mathematics**

Your ACT composite comes from the following sections: **English | Reading | Science | Mathematics**

We use your highest composite score! Take the ACT or SAT early and often.

## Will I get this scholarship every year?

If you qualify for a one-year freshman academic scholarship, you may receive scholarships for the fall and spring semesters of your freshman year if you complete 15 hours each semester with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

If you qualify for a four-year freshman academic scholarship, it may be renewed for a total of eight consecutive semesters if you complete 15 hours each semester with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Note: Receipt of any scholarship may affect your eligibility for other financial aid. Scholarships are distributed over two semesters, fall and spring.

## How do I apply for a Freshman Academic Scholarship and ENMU Foundation Starter Scholarship?

**Submit an ENMU Admission Application.** [enmu.edu/Apply](https://enmu.edu/Apply)

**Apply for freshman academic scholarship.** The deadline for priority consideration is Aug. 1 for fall and Jan. 3 for spring. Applications may be considered until two weeks prior to the beginning of the semester. [enmu.edu/ScholarshipsApp](https://enmu.edu/ScholarshipsApp)

**Provide transcripts.** Send us a copy of your national ACT/SAT scores and your official high school transcript. [enmu.edu/Transcripts](https://enmu.edu/Transcripts)

**Provide your ACT or SAT test scores.** To send your scores to ENMU, use the following codes on your ACT or SAT form: **ACT: 2636 | SAT: 4299**

**Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application.** Submit the FAFSA before the semester begins; you can submit online starting in October of your senior year.

**Register for classes.** Enroll in at least 15-credit hours at ENMU-Portales campus.
