State Competency #4

In an in-class essay, students will explain how globalization of the world's economy relates to the five economic stages of production (Primary, Secondary, Tertiary, Quaternary, and Quinary Activities).

Target :

Student demonstrates an understanding that Developed Countries (including the United States) exploits the natural resources of the Under Developed or Developing Countries, thus making Primary and Secondary Activities the typical stage of production for these countries, while Quaternary and Quinary Activities are typical for Developed Countries.

Acceptable:

Student correctly identifies that for Developing Countries Primary and Secondary Activities are the main contributors to their economy, while Quaternary and Quinary Activities are typical for Developed Countries.

Unacceptable:

Student fails to correctly distinguish which stages of production are typical for the Developing and Developed Countries.

Competency Goal:

The goal for this competency is that 75% of students will score at the Target or Acceptable level.
