- 005 Retiring Gov. Edwin L. Meachum wishes success to N.M. and Gov. Burroughs.
- 011 Wishes every citizen would accept feeling of responsibility that is his.
- 016 Hopes to achieve accomplishments which will benefit every segment of our population.
- 025 Public officials greatest problem is that of furthering the rights, privileges, and welfare of the private unorganized citizen.
- 029 Good government results from positive thinking and constructive action.
- 035 In between elections all should work toward common goals
- 039 Public official must be able to link together past, present, and future.
- 045 Government must incorporate an understanding of the human problems of people.
- 053 Shall attempt to work for common good and protect the indivisula freedom of citizen.
- 057 Shall try to improve means by which citizens can achieve freedom from poverty and insecurity.
- 060 Promise he will not be afraid to admit when he is wrong
- 062 As governor his motto will be: There is a job to do. Let's all buckle down and try to get it done.
