



# Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) Application

Enrollment Services

The Western Undergraduate Exchange program (WUE) is designed to allow a limited number of students from selected states to attend Eastern New Mexico University at a reduced tuition rate. The tuition for a WUE student at Eastern is the in-state tuition rate plus 50 percent. Students interested in attending Eastern as a WUE student must fulfill the following requirements:

- Apply for admission to Eastern New Mexico University by submitting an undergraduate application.
- Be a resident of one of the following states: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Washington or Wyoming.
- Be a first time attendee to Eastern New Mexico University.
- Be working towards your first undergraduate degree.
- Provide documentation that you are currently a resident in your home state.

### Admission requirements and continuation criteria:

#### Freshman

1. 2.50 or higher GPA and a 17 or higher ACT or 840 or higher SAT
2. Must maintain 15 hours per semester with a 2.50 or higher GPA
3. Limit four years

#### Transfers

1. 3.00 cumulative total GPA from all colleges attended
2. Must maintain 15 hours per semester with a 3.00 or higher
3. Limit two years

In addition to your application for admission and in order to qualify for the WUE program, we require at least two documents from the following list along with your completed and signed Residency Statement:

- Proof of voter registration in your home state
- Proof of vehicle registration in your home state
- Enlarged copy of your driver's license
