Study Abroad Malaga, Spain Summer 2017

The ENMU Department of Languages and Literature is inviting all students, faculty and employees to participate on our Study Abroad Program in Spain this coming Summer 2017.

Students will live and study in Málaga, Spain, known as Costa del Sol (The Sun's Cost) in the region of Andalucía, in the south of Spain. This is one of the most picturesque areas in Spain. Is a place where east meets west in an exotic melting pot of Jewish, Roman, Gypsy, Islamic, and Christian cultures. This is a land with extensive history and beauty which has inspired great writers, painters and architects.

Living with a host family is an integral part of the program and gives you a unique insight into Spanish culture by allowing you to become part of a Spanish Family. Student is also permitted to arrange other private living options.

The student can register in one or two of the following courses (course description below):

- SPAN 210 & SPAN 212
- SPAN 410 & SPAN 411
- SPAN 593 & 591
- ENG 447

Cost of the 4-week program:

- Housing and two meals a day for 4 weeks (400 euros, about \$420 dollars, paid directly to the family at arrival)
- Round trip to Spain (\$1,300 plus medical and travel insurance \$47)
- Excursions to Seville, Cordova, Granada, Alhambra, Rhonda and Paris, France (\$700) Includes transportation, hotel and admission to museums, palaces, etc. The student is responsible for his/her meals during the trips
- TOTAL PRICE: about \$2,467 plus tuition

Students and faculty from other disciplines and community members can also be accepted. It may also appeal to members of the local community who wish to brush up on their Spanish skills or to study the architecture, art, history, etc. of Spain.

Faculty members can use their tuition waivers to take one course.
