## Mandatory Dates, Requirements, Times and Locations

- Must be of Hispanic descent.
- Photo collage must show your Hispanic heritage
- Deadline for application is Thursday, Sept. 15 at 4 p.m. Drop off application at Office of Hispanic Affairs, located in the Student Success Center. No exceptions!
- Mandatory Informational Meeting is on Friday, Sept. 16 at 4 p.m. in the Sandia Room.
- Collage contest by voting will be Tuesday Sept. 20, 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in CUB Lobby.
- Crowning will be at about 12:45 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 20. (Depending on how long it takes to count votes).
- Must be present for all of contest duration.
- **In case of a tie**, contestants who are tied will give a short speech as to why “they should be the next Rey/Reina” and then the other contestants will vote on the winner.
- Must meet all deadlines and meetings.
- Must present themselves in a proper manner both in person and on social media.
- Winners must be able to attend mandatory dates and as many multicultural events as possible, including the following:
  - Banquets
  - Presentations
  - Homecoming events (game and parade)
- Only students, faculty and staff are allowed to vote.
  - **One** vote per person (One Rey, One Reina)
- Office of Hispanic Affairs will provide personalized ballots for voting.
- When promoting, **absolutely no handbills!**
- Contract signed after contest: scholarship divided between both semesters reigning.
- Must be able to reign for an entire year, from September to September.



**Recipient will receive a sash, crown and a \$200 scholarship divided between fall '16 and spring '17 if the following requirements are met:**

- Meets the time commitment and job responsibilities of office for the entire year
- Knowledgeable of Hispanic culture
- Attends banquets, events, presentations, etc., for which he is asked
- Provide a friendly and greeting face to ENMU community
- Present himself in a proper manner both in person and on social media
