**1. Purpose.** This Manual has been designed and developed to serve four (4) main purposes:

- A. As a procedural guide for the Board of Regents (the Board) of Eastern New Mexico University (the University) in organizing itself, holding meetings and taking action, in the same way as bylaws govern the operation of a corporate board of directors;
- B. To distinguish the responsibilities actually exercised by the Board from the functions delegated to the president of the University;
- C. As a source of information for others concerning the basic policies of the University and the procedures followed by the Board and
- D. As a codification of existing policies and procedures specifically required by law or approved by the Board in accordance with its general power to manage the University.

**2. Modifications.** This Manual and the policies included in its appendices may be modified by a majority vote of the Board of Regents at any of its meetings. It is the intention of the Board that proposed modifications will receive adequate publicity and discussion prior to their adoption.

**3. Parts of the Manual.** This Manual is divided into four (4) parts. They are:

10-1 Part One: Organization and Operation

10-2 Part Two: University Governance by the Board

10-3 Part Three: Financial Matters

The sections in each of the four (4) parts are numbered independently of the other three (3) parts.
