Defensive Driving Courses

In order to drive a University vehicle or an Enterprise vehicle for the University, the State of New Mexico requires you to complete a six-hour National Safety Council Defensive Driving course. There are two six-hour Defensive Driving courses to select from:

To register for the class, email sara.fares@enmu.edu. Upon registering, you will be given the location of the class. Bring your driver's license and pen/pencil.

Register for Parking

Make sure your vehicles are registered at Eastern New Mexico University. You can register as many vehicles as you would like and registration is free for all vehicles. University policy requires all vehicles to be registered on campus if they are going to be parked or operated on university property.

New parking decals are available at the ENMU Police Department. Parking decals for students, faculty, staff and community members are set to expire on Saturday, Jul. 1. The expiration date on your current decal is located in the lower left hand corner. The ENMU Police Department will resume enforcement for "Failure to Register" and "Expired Decal" on Monday, Aug. 28.

Contractor, visitor and temporary decals are also available at the ENMU Police Department. Applications for parking can be picked up at the ENMU Police Department.

New vehicle registration requires a completed application form to be presented in person at the ENMU Police Department for verification purposes along with a valid and current driver's license and state motor vehicle registration.

A renewal registration requires an applicant to simply come into the ENMU Police Department with their driver's license and state vehicle registration to verify information on file and receive a new sticker.
