### **New Mexico Broadcasting Association Awards**

Jacob Aranda became the first ENMU student to ever win an New Mexico Broadcasting Association Award. He won the Student Sportscaster Award for his broadcast on KENW-TV of ENMU's Greyhound women's basketball game against Wexas Texas A&M University in February.

Doc Elder, history professor, won three awards for the first time in the same year. He received the award for Sports Play-By-Play for his broadcast of the Greyhound men's basketball game against New Mexico State last December. He also won the award for Sports Show for an interview he did with Josh Prock after his game against UNM in November. Finally, he teamed with ENMU alums Lisa Schmidt and Kevin Robbins to win the Best Show Award for the Morning Throwdown.
