Interview with ENMU's President-Elect: Dr. Jeff Elwell

At its April 12 meeting the Eastern New Mexico University Board of Regents selected Dr. Jeff Elwell, dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Tennessee Chattanooga, as the new president of the ENMU system, which includes campuses in Portales, Roswell and Ruidoso.

He becomes ENMU's 10th president since its 1934 opening. Dr. Elwell will replace Dr. Steven Gamble, who has been president since 2001 and will retire at the end of June.

ENMU Hosting Alumni Golf Tournament in Santa Ana

Eastern New Mexico University's 8th Alumni Scholarship Golf Tournament will be on Friday, July 7, at the Santa Ana Golf Course in Santa Ana, New Mexico.

The golf tournament has raised a quarter of a million dollars in eight years for scholarships. Students whose relatives are alumni are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The tournament is open to everyone.

"The ENMU Alumni Scholarship Golf Tournament is one of our larger tournaments," says Santa Ana's PGA Apprentice Javier Chavez. The 27-hole course allows for play from 5,500 to 7,400 yards and features a 22,000-square-foot Club House accompanied by a four-star restaurant.

"ENMU was a great school," says alumnus George McGill who travels annually from the Garden State to support the ENMU Greyhounds through golf.

Deadlines for Fiscal Year End

Purchasing Cards: The Business Office suggests that purchases end June 19, 2017 to ensure the charges will reflect on the June statement. Statements will be ready to review on June 26. If you are traveling when the statements are due, please contact the Business Office at 562-2611. Completed statements must be in the Business Office by June 29. Ruidoso statements will be due by noon on June 30.

Interfunds: Interfunds for 2016-17 must be received by the Business Office by July 6. Interfunds received after July 6 will not be processed for payment. Examples of on-campus charges include: Sodexo, housing charges for camps, printing and duplicating charges, Physical Plant charges, etc.

Corrections to Accounts: Journal Vouchers and Budget Transfers are due in the Business Office by July 7.

As per ENMU's Travel Policy, all travelers seeking reimbursement of travel costs, should complete a Travel Voucher form within five (5) working days of the trip.

All travel for 2016-2017 must be submitted to the Business Office by June 30, 2017.

Reimbursement for prior months should be submitted for payment before June 1. If you are traveling on June 30 please contact the Business Office at 562.2611.

The last day checks will be cut for FY17 will be July 11, 2017.
