### **Ed Tatum Appointed to ENMU Board of Regents**

Ed Tatum, of Clovis, New Mexico, has been appointed by Gov. Susana Martinez to the Eastern New Mexico University Board of Regents.

Mr. Tatum is one of the founding members of Tatum and McDowell, a law firm in Clovis.

Mr. Tatum was the husband of the late Susan Tatum, an ENMU regent who passed away in February.

"I am very excited and honored to assume the position of my late wife, who did wonderfully," said Mr. Tatum. "I'm looking forward to working with the new administration at Eastern and continuing to make ENMU the best university in New Mexico and the surrounding states."

ENMU President Dr. J.S. Elwell said, "I am very glad to see that Ed Tatum has been appointed by Governor Susana Martinez. I had the opportunity to visit with him during the ENMU Foundation summer barbeque. I think he'll do a great job and I look forward to working with him, starting with the Sept. 14 meeting."

Dr. Dan Patterson, president of the Board of Regents, said, "I am extremely pleased about the appointment of Mr. Ed Tatum to the Eastern Board of Regents. Mr. Tatum is very familiar with the University and its programs.

"In addition, his background includes a tremendous amount of leadership skills and experiences that will be beneficial to the ongoing success of the board and the University.

"He has been a supporter of the University for a number of years and it is entirely appropriate that he be selected to fill the remaining years of his wife's term," said Dr. Patterson.

"I cannot think of a more welcome and appropriate appointment. I look forward, as I am sure does the rest of the board, to working with Mr. Tatum. This was an excellent choice!"

Mr. Tatum served as the vice president and director of the Curry County United Way from 1972 to 1978 and president and director of the Curry County Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development in 1982. He was a member of the New Mexico Corrections Commission from 1977 to 1980.

He was active duty in the United States Air Force from 1968 to 1972 and an attorney member of the Judge Advocate General Corps for the United States Air Force Reserve from 1972 to 2001.
