Qualifications

- 1. Applicant must be an active participant in the ENMU College Success Program and have taken a Learning Style Inventory or a Career Assessment.
- 2. At time of award, applicant must have received mid-term grades in their first semester—or if a continuing student, completed less than 60 semester hours.
- 3. Applicant must be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant and have unmet need.
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate satisfactory academic progress. (An applicant on probation will be considered, but a meeting must be established with the CSP director as soon as possible.)
