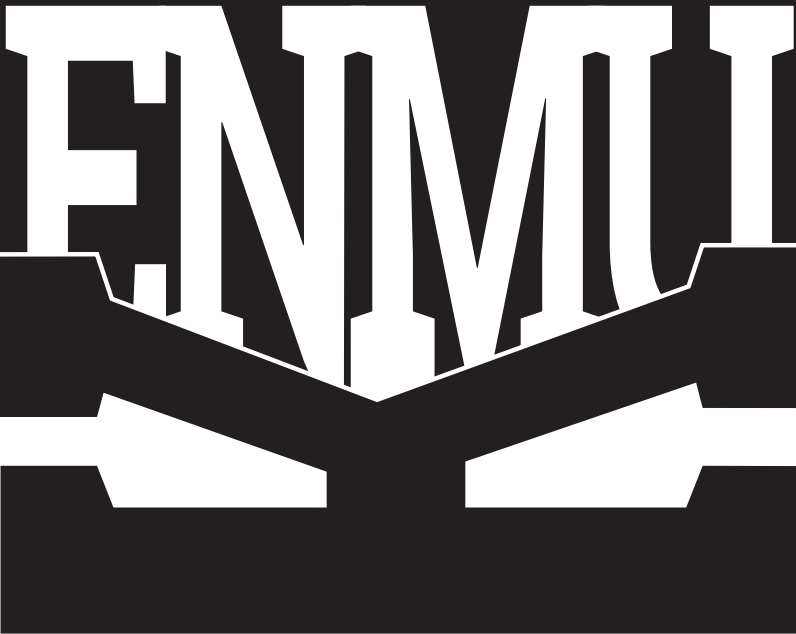

EXHIBITION GUIDELINES

Entry Deadline, Friday, March 9, 2018

ELIGIBILITY

Any public, private or homeschooled student in kindergarten through their senior year of college who is within 200 miles of Eastern New Mexico University is eligible to enter. A panel will choose up to four works per grade level for inclusion in the exhibition, as well as first, second and third place for each division and an overall Best of Show chosen from the entire body of work submitted.

ENTRY FEE AND NUMBER OF SUBMISSIONS PERMITTED

Entry fees are **not** collected for the juried exhibition. Artists may submit **one** piece of art.

MEDIA AND SIZE RESTRICTIONS

All media types are welcome. Artwork must be original, completed within one year of the entry deadline and may not have been previously shown at the Runnels Gallery. Artwork must be stable and able to fit through a standard doorway. Artwork that requires suspension from the ceiling, water, perishable food, or electricity is prohibited.

THEME/SUBJECT MATTER REQUIREMENTS

Artwork of any theme may be submitted to the exhibition. Artists will be adjudicated in the following areas and may consider these when selecting a piece for submission.

- **First Impression:** How powerful is the first impression?
- **Originality and Creativity:** To what degree of originality and creativity does the work have?
- **Artist's Voice:** Is the artist's voice felt in the work and can his/her personal perspective of the world around him/her be seen?

PRESENTATION READY REQUIREMENTS

All work must be finished at the time of delivery. Presentation standards include:

- **Submitted Two-dimensional Work**
 - Work must be matted or attached to display board. Suggested mat/display board colors are white, black, charcoal, or any shade of gray.
 - Paintings with large wooden stretchers with painted canvas overlap do not require framing.

- Dry mounting to foam/gator board with imagery flush (bleed off) to all four edges acceptable.
- **Submitted Three-dimensional Work**
 - Work must be stable.
 - Work requiring special/custom stands for presentation must be provided by the artist at time of delivery.

HOW TO ENTER

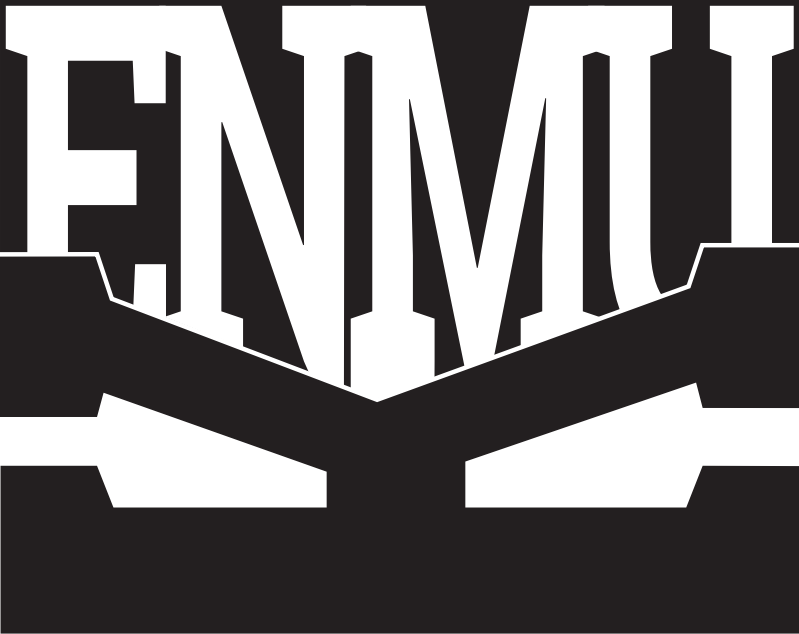
All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and can be submitted Monday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. or by appointment. Entries must be delivered to Bryan Hahn in the Eastern New Mexico University Department of Art, Office 111 located within the Art and Anthropology Building next to the KENW Broadcast Center. Work can be submitted directly by the artist, parent, artist's teacher or school administrator.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITION DATES

- **March 9, 2018, 5 p.m.** – Deadline to submit work to the juried exhibition
- **March 12-April 5, 2018** – Exhibition open to the general public for viewing
- **April 6, 2018, 7 p.m.** – Public awards ceremony and reception, Buchanan Hall, located within ENMU Music Building
