Teacher Education Program

Our Teacher Education Program advises and supports students who are interested in becoming educators. We provide you with the necessary professional education requirements to become licensed as a teacher in New Mexico. While our education program will prepare you for a licensure in New Mexico, there are opportunities to obtain your education licensure in other states.

Early Childhood Education

Choose this area of interest if you want to work with children from birth through grade 3. Opportunities exist in Early Head Start, Head Start, preschool programs and in public schools.

Elementary/Special Education Blended – Elementary and Special Education

Choose this area of interest if you want to teach students in kindergarten through grade 8 or if you have an interest in working with special needs students in pre-kindergarten through grade 12.

Secondary Education Junior High and High School

Choose this area of interest if you want to teach grades 7 through 12. With secondary education, you pursue a degree in a content area and work on your teacher education licensure at the same time.
